Format: Blog Post

Due Date: Your final date by 8 a.m. submitted on <u>turnitin.com</u> and posted to your blog. Late submissions (received by 8:31 or later) will not be accepted.

What must be covered:

Decision: You must make a statement that informs your reader whether or not you will continue posting to your blog and an explanation as to why.

Overview of Articles: This will be the post that will be at the top of your blog. Use this opportunity to inform your readers of what you have written and create links to those articles. (Ex: In my review < – Link, you can find my truest voice as a writer)

Reflection: Here you will reflect on your work as a journalist and the skills you have learned. Be specific here and reference how this will help you in the future as a student and contributor to society.

Thank You: Use this post as an opportunity to thank your readers. Reference why you are thanking them and be specific.

Mechanics: This blog post, as with every post, is expected to be perfect mechanically. You will lose 5 points for each error until you lose your 20 points for that section.

Word Count: Around 500-750 words
